You can present in one of three ways:

1. **Formal presentation:** Submit your presentation to the Gallery and attend the symposium in-person or virtually. Present your work live. Only formal presentations are eligible for judging and awards.
2. **Gallery presentation:** Submit your presentation to the Gallery only. Gallery presentations are not eligible for judging and awards.
3. **Work in progress:** Do you have an idea or a partial paper you would like to discuss? Prepare an informal short presentation and ask others for feedback and suggestions for the work. Just register and join us at the symposium.
